Directions: Teachers are to use their understanding of each word to create and orally give students a "Definition Clue" or definition. (For information on definition clues go to www.tampareads.com/definitionclues - After hearing the definition clue or definition, students write the correct word in the numbered column. While there are 8 words in each daily column (last word is a review word from previous week), only 7 words are to be tested in random order and may or may not include the review word. 3 points for each correct answer (84 max).
