- ship or even large groups of tires. A living reef, however, is made of millions of small creatures similar to a sea anemone. These creatures, sometimes referred to as polyps, are usually under 1/8 inch (3mm) and secrete a calcium substance for protection. A living reef is able to thrive in clear warm waters less than 200 feet (60 meters) deep. Because of fertilizer pollution and increasing water temperatures from global warming, scientists say \_\_\_\_\_\_ reefs are dying off and may someday vanish.
