	3. The word species is often defined as a basic category of organisms that resemble each other and are able to breed (reproduce) among themselves, but not with other species. Human beings belong to the species known as Homo sapiens, which is Latin for "wise man." DNA evidence suggests that modern humans appeared about 200,000 years ago in Africa. However, before modern Homo sapiens appeared, another sub-species of humans appeared in Asia and Europe about 350,000 years ago. This species of man was believed to have coexisted (lived together) with the modern Homo sapiens for about 15,000 years. They were heavily built but shorter than today's humans. Their skull was flat and elongated. The name given to describe these early humans is
