 13. At the end of several wars between England and France, peace was finally achieved in 1715 with the signing of the treaty known as the Peace of Utrecht. Spain was now in dire need of financial relief, so the King sent 11 ships to America to bring back urgently needed gold and silver. While returning to Spain, the ships encountered a hurricane along Florida's central east coast. The entire of 11 ships was destroyed on a reef, killing thousands of crew and stranding survivors on the hostile beach. 14. News of the 11 ships destroyed in the Florida hurricane spread. In early January 1716, the pirate Henry Jennings attacked the Spanish camp and would successfully gold coins and valuables. 15.
